In the Oppimp Atelier you can pimp up your own clothes under the guidance of an artist from The Hague without using a sewing machine. By sewing, stamping or embroidering something on your clothes, you can make your own T-shirt, pants or dress more fun. This makes your clothes more personal and hopefully less likely to be thrown away. Together we ensure a sustainable world!
